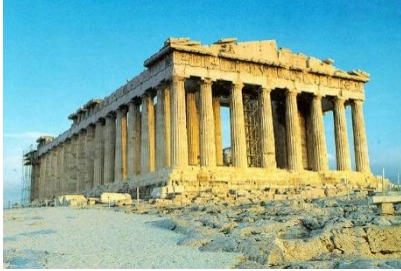


Day 01: Arrive Athens



Arrive Athens. After customs and immigration transfer to hotel. Dinner at Indian Restaurant. Overnight in Athens.

Day 02: Athens

After breakfast at hotel, visit all of the famous Athens sites on a City Tour including the Temple of Olympian Zeus, Hadrian's Arch and the famous Acropolis. Return to the hotel and free time to rest. In the evening we suggest you a walk at Plaka area where you will find a lot of shops for souvenirs and a lot of restaurants. Lunch and dinner at Indian Restaurant. Overnight in Athens.

Day 03: Athens – Mykonos

After breakfast at hotel you will be met and transferred to port of Rafina to take the ferry to Mykonos. Arrive in the evening at Mykonos & transfer to your hotel. Lunch and Dinner at Indian Restaurant. Overnight in Mykonos.



Day 04: Mykonos

After breakfast at hotel proceed for a tour to Delos. Uncover the archeological drama of Delos on a tour from Mykonos! With an expert local guide, cruise over the sea to the UNESCO-listed sacred island, and explore its main excavation site on a walking tour. Hear all about the island in the days of Ancient Greece, and admire highlights of the excavations including the Terrace of the Lions, House of Dionysus, Archeological Museum of Delos and more. Dinner at Indian Restaurant. Overnight in Mykonos.



Day 05: Mykonos – Santorini

This morning free time to enjoy a last swim at the blue crystal waters or some last shopping. Lunch at Indian Restaurant. Later transfer by ferry to Santorini. Arrive Santorini and transfer to hotel. Dinner at Indian Restaurant. Overnight in Santorini.

Day 06: Santorini

After breakfast at full day tour of Caldera and Oia (local lunch). Dinner at Indian Restaurant. Overnight in Santorini.

Day 07: Santorini - Athens

Breakfast at hotel. Post breakfast take the ferry to Athens. Arrive Athens and transfer to hotel. Check in at hotel. Dinner at Indian Restaurant. Overnight in Athens.



Day 08: Athens – Istanbul – Cappadocia

Breakfast at hotel. Check out and take a flight to Istanbul and then take a flight to Cappadocia. Arrive Cappadocia and transfer to hotel. Check in at hotel. Dinner at local restaurant. Overnight in Cappadocia.

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Day 09: Cappadocia

Optional early morning Hot Air Ballooning. Breakfast. Full day visit at Cappadocia . Visit **Göreme**



Open Air Museum - a UNESCO Heritage site, a fantastic region with its cave churches located on the valley. Lunch will be served at local restaurant. Then proceed to **Uchisar Village**, and **Paşabag Valley** that are famous with its spectacular fairy chimneys. Visit **Derbent Valley** with and explore the natural rock formations and get a chance to attend the workshops of carpets and onyx-stones . Overnight at the hotel.

Day 10: Cappadocia – Istanbul

Breakfast at hotel. Visit **Derinkuyu underground city** which is the largest of all others. Drive to **Ihlara village** and hike the Ihlara canyon (4 kms following the Melendiz river, visiting 11th century Rock churches) After having lunch in Belisirma village drive to visit **Selime Monastery** and **Agzikarahan Caravanserai**, very well preserved monument from 13th century Evening transfer to airport to take the flight to Istanbul. Arrive Istanbul and check in at hotel.



Day 11: Istanbul

Breakfast at the hotel . Hotel pick-up at around 07:50am. We begin our tour of the Sultanahmet district, the heart of old Istanbul, at Saint Sophia. Built by Emperor Justinian in the 6th century AD, this church is one of the marvels of world architecture. Its massive dome dominates the skyline of old Istanbul. It is famed for its mosaics, including glittering portraits of emperors and empresses. Next we visit the Blue Mosque, which owes its name to the exquisite tiles adorning its interior. Dating from the 17th century, it is the only imperial mosque with six minarets. The Hippodrome, the stadium of

ancient Byzantium, held 100,000 spectators and featured objects from all corners of the empire. Of these, an Egyptian obelisk and a bronze sculpture of three entwined serpents from Delphi survive. Afternoon; we begin our tour at Topkapi Palace, which, from the 15th to the 19th century, was the principle residence of the Ottoman Sultans. We will visit the fabulous Imperial Treasury and the Baghdad Kiosk. Topkapi Palace is now a museum and has unrivalled collections of jewelry, including the Spoonmaker's Diamond, the 3rd largest in the world, Ottoman court costumes and ceramics, notably one of the world's finest collection of early Chinese ceramics, much of it gifts from other rulers. Interestingly, some of the ceramics have a special glaze that was said to change color in the presence of poison. We also visit the Imperial Armory, displaying centuries of Ottoman weaponry. But perhaps the loveliest features of Topkapi Palace are its courtyards with their ancient trees, and it is easy to imagine the sultan strolling here far from the cares of state and empire. The last stop, Grand Bazaar, was the commercial heart of the old city and its 4,000 shops are full of treasures – including carpets and kilims, silks, jewelry, ceramics, icons, and leather goods. Wandering through the Grand Bazaar, indulge in some shopping, Ottoman style. Lunch and dinner at Indian Restaurant. Overnight in Istanbul.

Day 12: Departure



Breakfast at hotel. Post breakfast check out and Drive to
